



# USING WI-FI SAFELY

Do not do anything sensitive on public Wi-Fi. It is easy for attackers to view most of the things you're viewing.

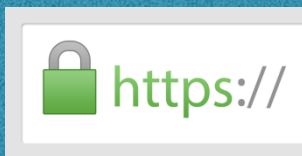


If you can, try and use only password protected Wi-Fi networks that use WPA-2,

When you are not on Wi-Fi, turn off Wi-Fi on your device.



If using unsecured Wi-Fi is necessary, ensure any sensitive information or logins are done over HTTPS - look out for the padlock.



Malicious Wi-Fi access points are easy to set up. Be careful what networks you join - **do not** just connect to any network.



On your home Wi-Fi network, change the name and password from the default your router comes with.
