

# Securing LinkedIn



## Request a copy of your archive

See what you have previously shared with others on LinkedIn. This will let you review your previous history on LinkedIn. The archive will show you information including login attempts, mobile apps and things you've shared on LinkedIn.

## Who do you connect too?

Only connect to people you know and trust. This limits the chances of connecting to an online scammer.

## Check your current connections

In your settings under Account, Basics, check and see what devices are currently connected to your LinkedIn profile. Remove all unnecessary ones immediately.

## Turn on Two Factor Authentication

Make sure that the option for two factor authentication is turned on to receive a security code every time an unrecognised device tries to connect to your account. This is found in settings > privacy > security.

## Watch out for phishing messages

Be careful what information you give out to people in private messages. Do you know the person? Do you trust them? Why are they asking those questions?

## Check what you are sharing

Turn on or off broadcast activity, select if your activity feed is public or not, select what others can see on your Public Profile. This is where you choose what to display on search engines - Choose wisely! This is under settings, account, privacy.

## Finally

Use the option to "View Profile as" to see what information others can gather about you and your business.
